



Earlscliffe Dress Code 2024-25

Students are expected to abide by the dress code below during school hours; Monday to Friday from 08:30 -16:30. Students may wear their own clothes in the evenings and at weekends and on designated non-uniform days which usually occur on the first Thursday of each half term. Students will be advised on what to wear for trips and special occasions.

Students taking the Level 3 Sports Course in Years 12 and 13 will be required to obtain a sports kit which they may wear instead of uniform on the days where they have sports lessons. Students taking the Sports Leader course will be able to wear their kit on the same day as SCS takes place.

Smart Business Attire	Suit in neutral colours Or Smart jacket <u>with</u> smart trousers, knee-length skirt or a matching dress.	Ostentatious/flashy/bright suits. Casual trousers (jeans, leggings). Skirts above the knee or with a slit. Evening wear dresses.

Footwear	Polishable professional shoes or smart ankle boots <u>with</u> socks or dark/tan coloured tights. Smart white socks may be worn if wearing a skirt.	Long boots, trainers (shoes that look like trainers), open-toed shoes, high heels above 3cm, suede or canvas, white or coloured soles. Sport socks or light coloured tights are not allowed.
Hair	Tidy and tied back from face when requested to by a member of staff. Clean shaven or fully grown in facial hair with it maintained neatly.	Unprofessional hair such as a grade one/zero or lines/shapes or bright dye. Scruffy or partially grown facial hair.
	Scrunchies, bobbles, clips, hair bands in neutral or school colours.	Extreme hair jewellery.
For Extra Warmth Indoors (Optional)	Smart black, grey, navy v-neck jumper/cardigan with jacket.	Jumper/cardigan worn without a jacket. Jumper/cardigan of the wrong colour, unprofessional design, or t-shirts.
Ties (Optional)	If wearing a tie then this must be the Earlscliffe tie (cost applies) on Mondays - Thursdays. On Friday, this can be a personal	Monday - Thursday: Other ties.
Earrings and jewellery (optional)	choice of tie. Small stud earrings, maximum one in each ear.	Long earrings, other visible piercings, or visible tattoos
	One plain necklace; worn inside clothing.	Multiple necklaces.
	One ring.	Multiple rings.
	One bracelet.	Multiple bracelets.

Makeup (optional)	Basic makeup such as foundation, mascara and lipgloss.	Brightly-coloured or elaborate makeup.
	Neutral, natural coloured, nail varnish.	Fake or brightly coloured nails.
	Clean Trimmed or professional length nails.	Nails longer than 1 cm from tip.
For Warmth Outside (optional)	Earlscliffe branded bench coat or rain jacket (available from sports kit supplier below) Or Plain dark-coloured outdoor coat	No logos, profanity or obvious branding.
An item of formal wear	Occasionally students may need to attend an event where an item of formal wear is required. A suit or black tie or a cocktail/evening dress should be worn with appropriate footwear. This particularly applies to the Valedictory event in the Summer term for all graduates and guests.
